Originally published in the 1990s by the FAA, this document has expanded and evolved through various iterations at TSA and now resides with Safe Skies as PARAS 0004 *Recommended Security Guidelines for Airport Planning, Design, and Construction*. The aviation security environment, and the technology that enables it, continues to evolve at a rapidly increasing pace. Consequently, this document also needs to evolve to accommodate the demands of the industry.
