The Project Statement below has been selected by the Safe Skies Oversight Committee and will be the starting point for a panel of experts to develop a Request for Proposals (RFP). The RFP is expected to be available in early 2021.

Sharing relevant, actionable information among stakeholders is an essential step in mitigating insider threats and addressing vulnerabilities. While existing documents such PARAS 0003 *Enhancing Communication and Collaboration Among Airport Stakeholders* provide broad guidance, there are still obstacles to effective and timely sharing of specific information, such as shift schedules, badge use data, etc. Compiling practical options and strategies in use or under consideration at airports to bridge these gaps will provide valuable information to further the industry's security efforts.

The objective of this research is to create a detailed resource of practical options and strategies for sharing specific types of data that can be used by security stakeholders to mitigate threats and address vulnerabilities.
