PARAS 0054 Strategies for Ensuring Compliance with Airport Rules and Regulations

The Project Statement below has been selected by the Safe Skies Oversight Committee and will be the starting point for a panel of experts to develop a Request for Proposals (RFP). The RFP is expected to be available in early 2023.

Airports use a variety of strategies to minimize non-compliance with security rules and regulations. Actions taken are generally monetary, operational, or administrative and might be taken against the individual violators or against tenants/badge sponsors. However, airports still face many challenges in ensuring compliance with security rules/procedures and leveraging actions for non-compliance. While some disparate guidance is available in various PARAS reports, a consolidated resource dedicated to successful enforcement strategies is needed.

The objective of this research is to provide guidance for compliance strategies and enforcement actions to deter non-compliance. Guidance should include options and strategies in place or under consideration, along with associated considerations for the various approaches. The guidance should be scalable and include strategies for airports developing compliance and enforcement programs and those seeking to optimize current programs.
